

Dangerous Dinosaurs



In the Dangerous Dinosaurs project, your child will find out about prehistoric animals that lived on Earth. They will learn facts about dinosaurs and discover how big some of these giant creatures were. They will learn about the difference between carnivores and herbivores. They will also find out about the animals that lived after the dinosaurs and which modern-day animals have prehistoric relatives.

We will be reading dinosaur stories, making moving dinos, going on a dinosaur trail and we will also have a go at making our own ammonites.

Sunshine and Sunflowers



In the Sunshine and Sunflowers project your child will explore the environment around the school to see how it has changed throughout the year. They will grow flowers, fruit and vegetables in the garden area. They will learn how to care for plants and animals, identifying some different types. They will take part in outdoor learning activities and find out how to stay safe in the sun.

We will be enjoying a picnic where we will invite class 1 to join us. We will make cakes and sandwiches for everyone to eat and play games.

How can you help at home?

- Read a bedtime story with your child and encourage them to join in.
- Ask your children what they have been learning that day/week and ask them questions to support and extend their learning.
- Encourage your child to write their name and practise early writing whenever they can. For example, practising their sounds, writing a shopping list, labels, or a post card.
- Provide practical situations where your child can apply their learning to real life contexts i.e. baking.
- And remember talk is fundamental to your child's learning.
