Autumn Term

In Brumble Bees this half term, we are welcoming our new friends and learning all about each other. We will be using our social skills to make friends and share all our lovely toys and learning to use our listening skills by having circle time and listening to stories on the carpet.



We will also be learning our shapes by going on shape walks, making pictures with shapes, matching shapes, dancing to shape songs, printing with shapes, making shape monsters, collecting shapes and describing what a shape looks like.

Winter Wonderland



In our Winter Wonderland project, we will explore the seasonal changes that happen during winter by going on Winter walks. We will find out about the different weather associated with the winter season and explore changes that happens to water as it freezes. We will also find out about what happens to plants and animals during cold weather and explore places in the world that are always cold and snowy, including the animals that live there and we will leave water out in a tuff tray to see what happens to it overnight and have fun breaking it with different tools in the morning.
