Dear Parents/Carers,

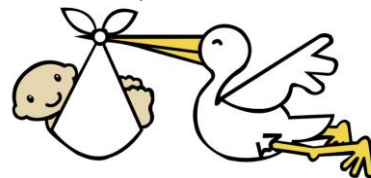
You will have noticed that we have a new gate at the front of school. After a couple of weeks of using it we now have some procedures to share with you so that things run smoothly:
