You will have received a curriculum newsletter for your child's class last week which details the learning your child will be doing this term. The Squirrel and Hedgehog class will be exploring castles through UK history where they will invade the castle's mighty walls, shoot a projectile with an archer's aim, head across the drawbridge, over the moat and up to the top of the tower.



The Fox and Owl class will also be studying an historical topic this term – 'Groundbreaking Greeks' where they will gain an understanding of where and when some key events during the ancient Greek period took place as well as gather evidence about the ancient Greek Olympics and make comparisons between the ancient Games and the modern Olympics.

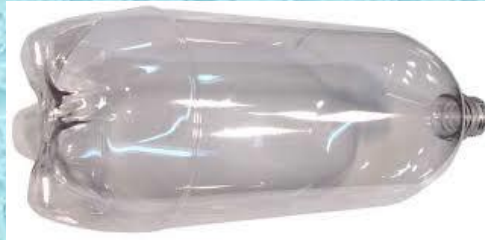
