Mrs Brown and Mrs Howard will be doing a new Brumble Bees Forest school activity on a different day each week so that every child should have a least 2 sessions of Forest School a term. We will try and let you know if it is your child's session that week.

In Brumble Bees this first half term, we are welcoming our new friends and learning all about each other – what our favourite foods are, learning who is in our families and drawing them. We will also be learning about our feelings and knowing what things makes us happy, sad, excited or scared.

We will be using our social skills to make friends and share all our lovely toys and learning to use our listening skills by having circle time and listening to stories on the carpet.



Sensational Seasons



In our sensational seasons project, we will explore the seasonal changes that happen during Autumn and Winter by going on walks and doing different activities in our Forest School sessions. We will find out about the different weather associated with the Autumn and Winter season and explore changes that happens to water as it freezes.

We will also find out about what happens to animals and birds during cold weather (hibernation and migration) and explore places in the world that are always cold and snowy, including the animals that live there. We will be reading some seasonal stories and talking about our experiences in the Autumn and Winter. We will be taking on a few exciting craft ideas such as making a snow globe, collaging some shiny pictures and making some stained glass leaves.
