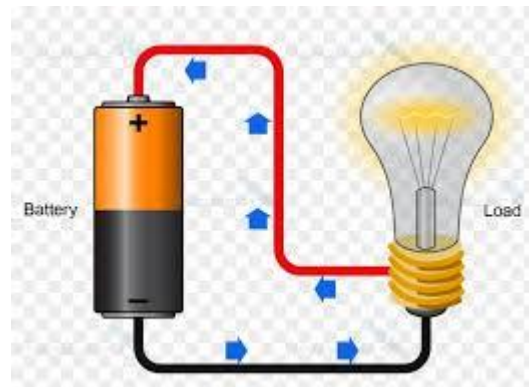
Amazing Machines

We will be using our social skills to make friends and share all our lovely toys, and learning to use our listening skills by having circle time and listening to stories on the carpet.

In the first half of the term, we will be looking at 'Amazing Machines!' We will be learning about boats, submarines, fire engines, trains, tractors and aeroplanes.



We will make our own boats out of junk to see if they float, guessing if objects will float or sink and making telescopes and seeing what we can see on the field. We will be putting out a real fire (supervised by Mr Brayley!) in forest school, and making our own firefighter helmets. We will work together as a team to see if we can make an electrical current and light a bulb.



We will be looking at what all the different farm machinery does, decorating paper body outlines and discussing if anyone has been on an aeroplane before. We will also be making our very own paper aeroplanes to fly on the field.

In this topic, we will be reading fairytales such as Jack and the beanstalk, Cinderella and Rumpelstiltskin.

We will be trying to write our names with gold thread, sorting a variety of different beans with tweezers to get our fingers strong and making wishes to send to the wish fairy and seeing if we get a reply from her! We will also try and make our own fairies with coffee filters.
